activities **create the Museum of Survivors which opens in 2025** to mark 80 years since the end of World War 2. We need your help to "Make a Museum".

THE CURRICULUM PROVIDES:

1 Classroom teaching activities of 45 minutes, using testimonies of survivors.

2 Online co-design meetings with experts to get inputs from the students from 5 countries.

3 Review and contribution to each part of the Museum, including iWalks and digital activities. Each class can contribute a project to the Museum from their school.

There will be **5 learning activities based on testimonies of Schindler Jews** that **we invite you to** pilot with students during this school year. Besides that, we will organize **online events to deepen the impact of our project** and to reach the entire international student ambassador community of the program throughout the year.

The **activities will be available in Czech, English, German, French and Hungarian**. The activity about the film, Schindler's list and the second about Emilie Schindler are the first activities for piloting. The rest of the activities will be released according to the year plan.

We will also give you **some suggestions** for preparatory material in case you need them for students who will be piloting the testimony activities.

We also kindly ask you to **circulate an attendance sheet to be signed** by all participants during every activity and any event related to or associated with the project. We also **evaluate the impact** of our project with a pre and post questionnaire.

We encourage you to work at your own pace, however, we created a suggested schedule/ year plan to support you. Our educational team will be in contact with you to support all activities.
